



2017 PLIA Loan & Grant Program Applicant Ranking

PLIA's Underground Storage Tank Revolving Loan and Grant Program provides capital financial assistance to owners and operators of petroleum underground storage tanks who wish to:

- Replace or upgrade aged fuel systems.
- Clean up past contamination caused by an underground storage tank release
- Upgrade infrastructure to dispense alternative fuels.

PLIA partners with the Department of Health for some of the financial administration of the program.

Award Cycle 2016-2017

PLIA received 43 applications for the program. After attending an intake meeting with PLIA, 41 applicants entered into the Preliminary Planning Process (PPA). PLIA completed all 41 PPAs in less than six months to provide applicants with critical data about the conditions at their site. After reviewing the data submitted by applicants and collected during the PPAs, PLIA ranked each site according to the prioritization criteria listed in the program guidance document (Washington Pollution Liability Insurance Agency Loan and Grant Guidance Publication No. 02-2016-04).

Once a statewide Capital Budget is passed, PLIA will move to the next step in the loan and grant process.
