

PLIA Heating Oil Insurance Program (HOIP)

Why You Should Register

- Property owners are responsible for cleaning up contamination from tank leaks.
- Pollution coverage is often not available from private insurance companies.
- There is no cost to the owner for this coverage.

What Is Covered

- PLIA pays up to \$60,000 to clean up contamination from a heating oil tank when not covered by other insurance, and for contamination on your property and a neighboring property.
- The contamination must come from a leak that starts **after** the heating oil tank is registered with us. The tank may be underground, aboveground, or in a basement.
- Reimbursement of up to \$1,500 to repair damages on neighboring property (third party coverage), such as landscaping, flooring, painting, etc.

What is Not Covered

- Leaks from abandoned or decommissioned tanks, or other sources.
- Leaks that start *before* the tank is registered with PLIA.
- Property restoration on your property (first party coverage).
- Removal, repair, or replacement of the tank, lines, and furnace. This does not include reimbursement of new tank replacement costs.
- Heating oil lost in the release.

Registration Information

- PLIA will only accept registrations for tanks registered in the program before 7/2/2020 and a change in ownership with the previously registered tank took place within the last 180 days of the ownership change.
- To transfer a registration, you must complete and submit page 2 of this brochure.
- PLIA will send you a confirmation of registration within 14 days.
- If you do not receive a confirmation letter within 14 days, please call us at 1-800-822-3905.

How to File a Claim

- You must first confirm that a leak from your tank has occurred. Call PLIA (1-800-822-3905) as soon as you can to begin the claim process.
- You have 30 days from the when the tank is disconnected from the furnace to file a claim. If it is more than 30 days after the leak started, then the claim will not be covered.
- We will investigate the claim, which may include taking photos of your property and the failed tank.
- You must hire a contractor from the list we provide to you.
- PLIA must approve work before the cleanup begins prior to making insurance payments.

Real Estate Transactions

- When a registered owner sells the property or transfers ownership in any way, the coverage under the Heating Oil Insurance Program will end unless the new owner registers within 180 days from the date of the property transfer.
