

Technical Assistance Program

Does your site qualify* for the Technical Assistance Program (TAP)?

YES



- You have a qualified tank system.
- There is a known release.
- The release does not impact sediment or surface water,
or
- You have funding from another PLIA program to pay for cleanup activities.

NO



- You do not have a qualified tank system.
- The release impacts sediment or surface water.
- Petroleum is co-mingled with non-petroleum contaminants.¹
- The site is part of larger cleanup sites.²
- The site is enrolled in Ecology's VCP.³
- The site is in litigation.

**PLIA and Ecology may exclude some factors after review of site characterization.*

¹ Co-mingling of incidental contaminants is allowed.

² Sites that are located within or impact a Superfund Site, Nuclear Managed Site, Industrial Section Site, or is a Dangerous Waste Site managed by the Hazardous Waste Toxics Reduction Program.
