

How to: Request an Opinion

You may request a written opinion from PLIA for any proposed or completed remedial action at the site.

1. Select the Project

To request a written opinion, select the project you are requesting this for from the project list. From the project page, click “New Opinion Request.”



2. Identify the Type of Opinion Requested

Check the correct box(es) to indicate the type of opinion requested. More than one type of opinion may be requested at

If you select Other Opinion, explain what type of opinion you are requesting in the Other Opinion Requested box.

List the name(s) of the report in the Relevant Report(s) box.

Click “Save.”

Please Note: If you are requesting an NFA with an Environmental Covenant, please select both the “Cleanup Complete (NFA)” & “Other” options. This will help PLIA track the Environmental Covenant as it goes through the process.

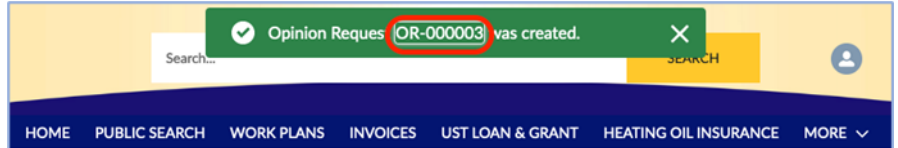

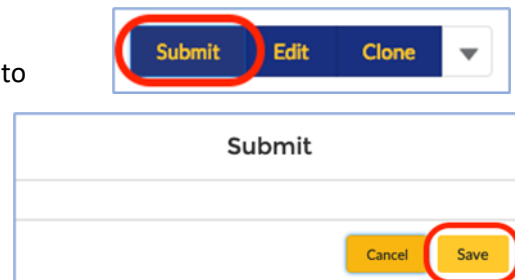
3. Upload Report(s)

Use the Upload Files link on the Project page to upload your relevant report(s).



4. Submit


When your reports have been uploaded and your Opinion Request is complete, click “Submit,” then “Save” to complete the request.



After submission, the opinion request will have a status of "Submitted" and will list the anticipated date the opinion will be provided.

Please Note: If an Environmental Covenant is being requested, there will initially be a date in this field.

However, PLIA will remove this date manually after submission due to the complex nature and timelines of Environmental Covenants.
